DESCRIPTION:

All the bunkers of the famous Club de Golf Islesmere's 27 holes were completely rebuilt during the past few years. The works had two main goals, refurbish the bunkers which were often filled with rocks, and harmonize the bunker styles between the club's three nines to ensure that the third nine, often perceived by the members as less interesting and less appealing, could blend with the first two nines, built more than 40 years before. The occasion was also used to rethink the positioning of a couple of the bunkers in order to increase their strategic value.

Today, the result of this great collaboration between the architect, the contractor and the course superintendant are new bunkers with pronounced faces and characteristic shapes, recognized as some of the most beautiful and fearsome in Quebec.
