DESCRIPTION:

The Club de Golf de la Vallée du Richelieu has almost completely rebuilt its Verchères Course over the past few years. Outdated by years of use and poor construction materials, the Verchères Course was not a favorite of the members of the club who preferred the Rouville Course, often perceived as more interesting. Following the works, the situation was quickly reversed and the Verchères course became the favorite. This has since forced the club to perform work on the Rouville course to even out the play on the club's two courses.

The goal of the project was to differentiate the Verchères course from the Rouville course and to diversify the course strategy and its aesthetic appeal. All while creating a course with a distinctive appearance that would make it unique amongst Quebec golf courses.
